

SEPARATION AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, is made and entered into on this _____ day of _____, 2009, by and between _____, hereinafter referred to as "Husband", and _____, hereinafter referred to as "Wife".

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the parties hereto are Husband and Wife, having been lawfully married on __ in the County of __, State of __;

WHEREAS, the parties are and have been living separate and apart since _____; and intend to live separate and apart permanently; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto have agreed upon a settlement of all marital affairs, and desire that the same be set in writing so that each party will be fully and completely advised as to his or her rights, duties and obligations.

WHEREAS, the Wife/Husband agrees to relinquish any and all interest she has in the marital home located at _____ **[THIS IS WHERE YOU DECIDE WHO MAINTAINS THE MARITAL HOME]**

NOW THEREFORE, in compromise, adjustment and settlement of all issues regarding marital property, personal property, and alimony/spousal support, and in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises herein set forth, the parties to this agreement do hereby agree with each other as follows:

1. That the Husband and Wife have no minor children and none are expected.
2. The parties agree that neither party shall pay to the other any spousal support.
3. The parties agree their marital property will be divided as follows. **[THIS IS WHERE YOU DIVIDE YOUR PROPERTY]**
4. The parties agree that each shall be responsible for his or her own debts made in their name and each shall not be responsible for the current debts or future debts of the other.
5. That the parties agree that they shall each have the right to associate with whomever they choose, and to live their lives separately as if they are not married, and that neither party will interfere with the affairs of the other.
6. That it is understood and agreed that this Separation Agreement shall be filed with the commencement of the divorce proceeding and incorporated and made a part of the Final Decree of Divorce.
7. That the provisions of this agreement and their legal effects are fully

understood by both parties and each party acknowledges that the agreement is fair and equitable, that it is being entered into voluntarily, and that it is not the result of any duress or under influence.
